A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends,

On May 7th, 15 people along with Fr. Matt and I, departed for a 12-day pilgrimage to France, specifically put together to connect us with our Patroness, St. Therese of Lisieux, the Foundress of the Little Sisters of the Poor, St. Jeanne Jugan, and the Mother of Our Lord. Here is the itinerary of our travels:

Friday, May 8 – Paris | Lisieux

Arrive in Paris before transferring to Lisieux, home of St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus. Celebrate Mass in Lisieux.

Saturday, May 9 – Lisieux

The morning begins with Holy Hour at the Basilica of Lisieux, followed by a private Mass and guided tour. Visits include Les Buissonnets, the childhood home of St. Thérèse, and time for prayer with the Carmelite sisters at the Carmel Chapel.

Sunday, May 10 – Normandy Beaches

Experience a day trip to the Normandy coast. Celebrate Mass on Omaha Beach, followed by visits to the American Cemetery and the historic town of Arromanches.

Monday, May 11 – Mont Saint-Michel

The pilgrimage continues with a journey to the breathtaking Mont Saint-Michel. Upon arrival, Mass is celebrated at Church of Saint-Pierre, and the renowned Abbey is explored.

Tuesday, May 12 – Saint Pern

The day is dedicated to visiting the Motherhouse of the Little Sisters of the Poor in Saint-Pern. Mass is celebrated with the sisters, followed by a tour of their community.

Wednesday, May 13 – Chapel of the Miraculous Medal | Paris

Depart for Vernon to celebrate Mass at Notre Dame of Vernon Collegiate as well as time spent in Claude Monet's Gardens in Giverny.

Thursday, May 14 – Notre Dame Cathedral | Sainte Chapelle

This morning, celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, where Mary appeared to St. Catherine Labouré. A visit to the Chapel of Saint Vincent de Paul follows.

Friday, May 15 – Montmartre

The day begins with a tour of the newly restored Notre Dame Cathedral. We will then arrive at Sainte Chapelle, known for its radiant stained glass, where Mass will be celebrated in the crypt of the Basilica of Sacré-Coeur, followed by a guided tour and time for adoration.

Saturday, May 16 – Return to USA or Lourdes Extension

Those continuing onward begin the post-tour retreat with a high-speed TGV train to Lourdes.

Saturday, May 16 – Paris | Lourdes

Arrival in Lourdes, where Mass will be celebrated, and in the evening, we will participate in the nightly Candlelight Procession.

Sunday, May 17 – Lourdes

The day begins with celebrating Mass at the Grotto, followed by visits to the Boly Mill and the Cachot.

Please rest assured all of you and your intentions will be prayed for every step of the way, and Fr. Matt and I look forward to sharing the spiritual significance of this pilgrimage when we arrive back in the parish after May 18th.

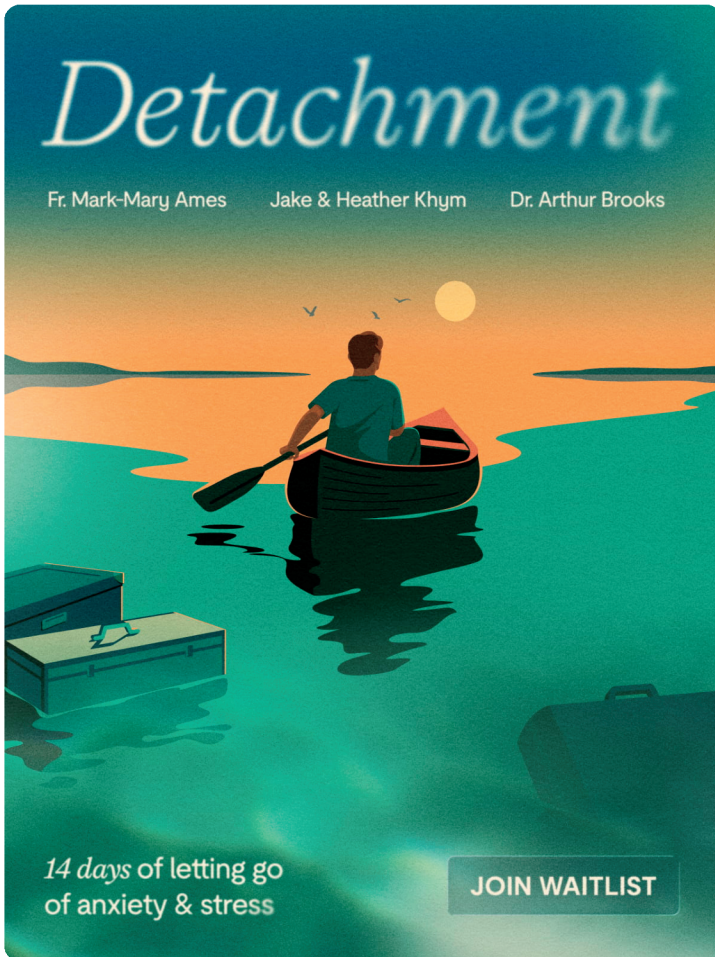

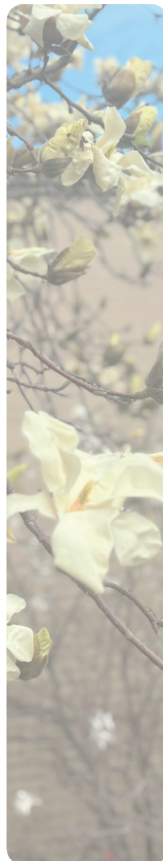

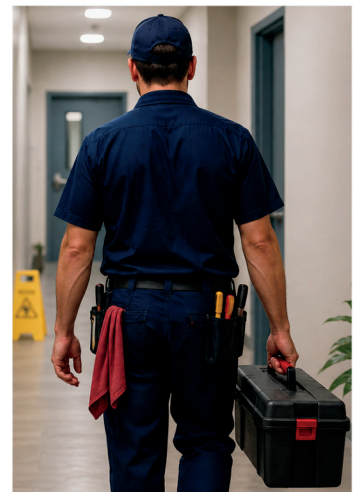

GOSPEL MEDITATION

May 10, 2026
6th Sunday of Easter
John 14:15-21

In my family, we can hardly speak about orphans without tears. My father was adopted as a baby. He frequently told us stories of how his parents welcomed him not just into their home but into their hearts. It was never merely a relocation or a legal transaction. It was the joy of being chosen, of receiving a family, a name, and a place where he belonged forever. Even in his later years, recalling that gift still moves him to tears of tender gratitude.

That is the kind of tenderness behind Jesus' words in today's Gospel: "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you." (John 14:18) He is going away, but not abandoning us. Instead, he sends us the Advocate, the Holy Spirit — his own Spirit, shared with the Father — who dwells in us. Through the Spirit, Christ is present in us, and we are present in him. His Spirit gives us a home and a family.

We deepen this knowledge in the sacraments, in prayer, and in the daily life of the Church. The Spirit is the bond of belonging, the power that makes us God's sons and daughters, not spiritual orphans. And this is not a one-time event. There is always a deeper outpouring of the Spirit available to us, a fresh appropriation of the promise that we are never abandoned.

If only we could be as grateful as my dad is for his adoption, realizing that we have been adopted by God Himself. In Christ, we are never left as orphans.
