






A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Fr. Tim Fairman

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life."

THE GOSPEL OF JOHN 3:16



Dear Friends,

On Friday, January 5th, our latest depiction of beauty arrived in the Adoration Chapel...the statue of St. Thérèse of Lisieux and her father, St. Louis Martin, which was placed in its permanent home, the back niche directly opposite the sanctuary. As some people have already asked questions about the statue, I asked Fr. Matt to share a reflection on the significance of what the statue depicts. I am grateful he was able to do so below. Thanks, Fr. Matt!

Some people have asked, "*Where is Thérèse's mother, St. Zélie*"? The depiction of Thérèse with her father is that of the moment in Thérèse's life when her father gave her away to be a bride of Christ as she made her final vows, long after her mother had passed.

The reason why Louis is prominent, however, is not just historical. He is the inspiration behind Thérèse's choice to add "...and of the Holy Face" to her religious name — thus her full name as a Carmelite was Thérèse of the Child Jesus and of the Holy Face. This is also why we asked the artist Cody Swanson to depict him holding the Veil of Veronica, which was an image very dear to the Little Flower.

In a Liturgical context, the Holy Face of Jesus is often associated with devotion to the Holy Eucharist - to adore the Blessed Sacrament is to adore and worship the Holy Face of Jesus which was so beaten and spat upon in His agony. This is also a reason why Eucharistic Adoration is considered an act of reparation for the unrequited love and indifference that we often commit against the God who is Love. Because the Eucharistic adoration chapel at St. Theresa Church is named after the Holy Face, which is a devotion so dear to the Martin family, it made sense to us to make St. Louis a prominent figure of inspiration to those who visit the adoration chapel seeking to get closer to God.

Above the new statue is the inscription in Latin for one of the many titles found in the Litany to the Holy Face, "VULTUS VERUS PATRIS AETERNI." The architect poignantly placed this above the niche where the statue will repose, and it fits splendidly with the tenderness that the images were meant to convey. It translates,


"True Face of the Eternal Father." You may notice that **St. Louis is gazing above at the vault of stars - a real moment that occurred between the father and daughter in her autobiography, only in our statue, St. Thérèse is no longer transfixed by the astral sky. She's contemplating Heaven through the Sacred Host at the altar. In her autobiography, the Little Flower wrote:**

At about eight o'clock Papa would come to bring me home, and I remember how on the way I looked up at the stars with untold delight. Orion's belt, like a cluster of diamonds hung in the deep vault overhead, had a wonderful fascination for me because I saw in it a likeness to the letter "T." "Look, Papa!" I would cry, **"my name is written in Heaven!"** Then, no longer wishing to see this dull earth, I would ask him to lead me on, while with head thrown back, I gazed unweariedly at the starry skies.

Accordingly, St. Louis' head is tilted back, beckoning us all to look up towards Heaven. St. Thérèse, meanwhile, reminds us that Heaven is in the tiny host, and after Holy Communion, inside of us. This choice of the statue's directional gaze finalizes the inscription at the front of the Chapel to the right of the altar. One can almost imagine the nearly life-sized statue of St. Thérèse at the back saying exactly what is written in the aedicule at the front:

From now on, near the Eucharist, I shall be able to sacrifice myself in silence, to wait for Heaven in peace. Keeping myself open to the rays of the Divine host, in this furnace of Love, I shall be consumed, and like a Seraphim, Lord, I shall love You.

Finally, we felt sincerely that the image of fatherhood and masculine identity is becoming subject to many hostile and often toxic ideologies that belittle and remove the importance of men from culture, family, and the overall human identity. A good male role model for the family is so gravely needed today, especially in the life of the Church and of American Society. While



Drafting, finalizing, editing, and creating this image of St. Thérèse and St. Louis took nearly 3 years. Our hope is that this statue will complete the overall atmosphere and theology surrounding the architecture of the Adoration chapel. We further hope that this new statue somehow reveals the dignity inherent in all human life - this dignity of being made in the Image and Likeness of God, made especially true when we are in communion with each other and with Christ at the altar. We are ever grateful to the difficult and arduous labor of love from our Architect Mr. Thomas Rajkovich and the master artist himself, Mr. Cody Swanson. It goes without saying that this project would have been impossible without the generosity of our private benefactor. Thank you for helping us crown our Adoration Chapel with this inspiring work, which graces us now and future generations yet to come.

May this chapel endure, attract more visitors, regular adorers, inspire holy vocations, and leave a legacy of Eucharistic revival for this part of the Archdiocese of Chicago.


Moms Group Corner | Moms & Kids Second Semester 2024


